CAMPGROUND RULES

Please use common sense when making any sort of decision at the Campground and remember that we are a family campground. Those violating the rules or causing a disruption will be asked to leave without a refund or rain check.

Must be 18 years old or older to book and must be present at sign in and during the stay.

Campsites can have one RV and one tent if both fit – but no more than 8 people, per Michigan law, in total on the site. Daytime guests must register and pay a fee and must leave the campground by 11:00 pm. Campers and visitors will be required to wear wristbands on event weekends and other busy periods.

Two vehicles per site (only one for events for event campers). No parking on roads or on other sites.

No powered scooters, mini-bikes, mopeds, go-carts, side by side vehicles, ATVs or UTVs or anything of the like are permitted at the Campground. Golf carts are allowed by permit only. Contact campground for information.

No glass bottles in the park, by the creek, in the bathrooms or other facilities or at the vendor area. No underage drinking permitted.

No outside firewood is permitted. All firewood must be purchased from the camp store – deliveries can be made to sites for larger quantities. No scavenging for firewood in the woods. Don't burn anything other than firewood in your campsite. Make sure fires are out if you leave your site and don't place firepits too close to tents, RVs, sheds, etc.

After quiet hours begin, campers can still have campfires, etc but should keep noise to a minimum so that neighboring campers are not disturbed. No generators may be run during quiet time. The playing of loud music, use of large speakers, or causing excessive noise is prohibited at all times.

Don't cut through occupied sites – use roadways and paths. Don't put your belongings or vehicles on another site, even if the other site is empty. Don't use electric or water from other sites.

No dumping of grey or black water in sites on the property other than at the designated dump stations. Schedule a Honey Wagon service or use the dump stations (with portable camping equipment).

No subleasing of sites is permitted without permission. No peddling or selling of merchandise from your site.

The Campground has a creek, woods and other features that require supervision of children at all times. **Children should not be allowed to wander the campground unaccompanied.**

Use of firearms, BB guns, water pistols/guns/canons, weapons of any kind, spotlights, laser pointers, and *any type* of FIREWORKS are not permitted. Use of these will result in immediate eviction.

Water is for personal consumption and hygiene. Use of water in pools, truck beds, barrels etc is prohibited. Small kiddie pools are allowed but should be emptied and put away after use.

EV Vehicles – don't charge electric vehicles on sites. This will result in immediate eviction and may result in additional damages being charged to you if an electrical issue is caused by your use.

Keep site clean and take garbage to designated dumpsters or trash compactor.

Lewd, obscene, or other offensive conduct, products or signage is NOT permitted. Be respectful of your neighbors.

There are no lifeguards at the Creek and the water is not subject to testing by the County or the State.

Dog Policy: Guests may have up to 2 dogs at their site. Visitors cannot bring dogs unless they register with the Campground. All dogs must be vaccinated, and record must be brought with the dog.

All dogs must be on leashes when outdoors with responsible parties and cannot be left outside without you. Dogs should not be chained to trees.

Keep dog's barking to a minimum. Excessive barking will result in the dog not being allowed at the Campground.

Dogs should not be left unattended in your RV for long periods of time.

Dogs are not allowed in the bathrooms, play areas, store shop/office at any time or the vendor area during events.

Pick up after your dog immediately and dispose of the bag in the garbage.

The dog park is open to all dogs that get along well with other dogs. Otherwise, please don't use the dog park.

Do not bring aggressive dogs to the Campground. If your dog is deemed to be aggressive, in Campground's sole discretion, the dog will be excluded from the Campground.

You are responsible for any and all damage caused by your dog or any dog of someone visiting or staying on your site.

Refunds: No refunds will be granted for partial stays or for inclement weather or other conditions that occur at campgrounds. Most reservations can be cancelled up to 30 days prior to the arrival date for a full refund less a cancellation fee. Cancellations within 30 days of arrival are not entitled to any refund.

Risks of Camping: The Camper recognizes and accepts all risks associated with camping in nature and around other people. The Campground is not responsible for any damage or harm to your camper, personal belongings, or your person whether by vandalism, Act of God, Act of Nature, other campers' negligence or bad acts, or by any other cause or source. Your RV must have liability insurance and you should be prepared to provide evidence if requested.

Failure to follow Campground rules may result in you being required to leave the campground with full forfeiture of any fees paid but not yet used. Guests will be held responsible for any loss or damage to the Campground facilities caused by anyone using their site including day visitors.
